



GOLDEN RULES FOR THE FREEZER

Ice cream lovers count on the very best quality when they buy an OLA ice cream from you. OLA works closely with manufacturers to develop energy-efficient freezers. Some advice to help you reduce environmental impact and save costs can be recognized by the environmental logo. In addition, a good appearance of the freezer (clean, no icing, baskets) will make consumers decide more quickly to make a purchase. To ensure quality, it is important that the freezer functions optimally. Read our Golden Rules below to see how best to proceed!

HOW TO PLACE THE FREEZER

1



Do not place the freezer outside in the sun, close to a heat source or in a warm room. Do not place the freezer under an air conditioner or near a door.

2



Always keep 15 cm free around the freezer, especially the ventilation grille and lids. Do not use an extension cord and use a grounded outlet.

3



Check the temperature of the ice cream at the time of receipt. Preferably, the temperature of the ice is -18 degrees or colder.

THIS IS HOW TO FILL THE FREEZER

4



Use of baskets ensures optimal distribution of cold air. Place the ice cream according to First-In-First-out principle (shortest shelf life at the top).

5



The temperature at the bottom of the freezer is much lower at the loading line. Always make sure no ice is above the loading line.

6



Stack the ice cream up to the height of the basket or the load line at most. Carefully open the outer boxes and carefully place the ice cream in the baskets (do not empty boxes).

MAINTENANCE AND DAILY USE

TIPS FOR DAILY USE

Check regularly that the freezer is closed properly and make sure that the lids are not opened unnecessarily. This will prevent ice formation.

8



Check daily temperature between the ice in the center of the freezer if it is colder than -18 degrees. See HACCP guidelines for legal requirements.

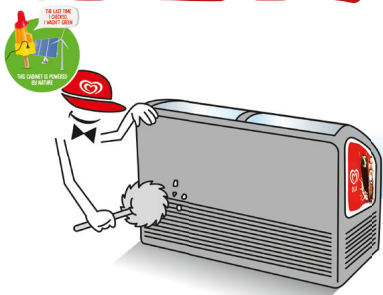
9



Remove products that are damaged, defrosted or have expired expiration dates. Never freeze thawed products again!

MAINTENANCE

10



Make sure that the ventilation grids are always free of dust and clean. Use a vacuum cleaner or a brush for regular cleaning.

11



Dirty condensers use more energy the condenser is located behind the grille. Clean it regularly with a soft brush.

12



Remove frozen ice regularly with a plastic scraper. If this does not work, defrost the freezer and remove the melt water.

PROBLEMS WITH YOUR FREEZER?

13



Quickly place the products in another freezer if you have one available.

14



Not working out? Leave the ice in the freezer keep the freezer closed. Cover the freezer with insulating material.
